Tolga and Xu,

I acknowledge that you are not happy with the school district's position regarding D . It seems your biggest concern is "clearing his name." As I explained to you there is no school district process or legal procedure for declaring him innocent and clearing his name. But your potential choice to return him to Wolf Springs is going to further damage his reputation because their plan in that event is to establish strict rules for D , including not allowing him to bring a backpack; frequent inspections of him throughout the day; assigning a monitor, etc. All of these requirements will further identify him as a subject of concern; he will know that; the other children will know that. I just don't see how that helps and I see the likelihood of substantial harm to his self-esteem and feeling of being accepted.

The transfer offer also avoids a disciplinary record which D will have if he returns to Wolf Springs. You are so clearly unhappy with his school and their personnel going back to October. A transfer gives your whole family a fresh start. Please consider the matter and let me know Monday.
